

ACLO Civil Liability Policy

1 Definitions

- 1.1 The Foundation: Stichting ACLO, statutorily established in Groningen, registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number 41009087.
- 1.2 Sports certificate: a subscription purchased by a natural person as referred to in Article 2 of the general terms and conditions of the foundation.

2 Liability

- 2.1 The Foundation considers the conduct mentioned below to be unlawful conduct within the meaning of Article 6:162 of the Dutch Civil Code.

3 Black sports

- 3.1 If a natural person cannot show a sports card before, during, or after using the Foundation's facilities, nor can they prove that they have purchased one, they will be held liable for the damages suffered by the Foundation to the amount of €20. Unless the damage is compensated by purchasing a sports card from the Foundation, the compensation will be set at €10.
- 3.2 A sports card is personal and therefore non-transferable. If a natural person receives a sports card from another person, that person will be held liable by the foundation for damages incurred by the foundation amounting to €20.00, unless the damages are compensated by purchasing a sports card from the foundation, in which case the compensation is set at €10.00.

4 Damage to physical elements

- 4.1 The Foundation will hold any natural person liable in all cases for the full amount of damages incurred by that person to facilities, materials, concessions, or instructors belonging to the Foundation or under its responsibility. The Foundation will always report theft or deliberate vandalism to the police.
